Description and Sources

Description

Mid C19 public house. Coursed limestone rubble. Welsh slate roof. T-plan with central projecting mock timber-framed porch to centre of 3-bay main block. Two storeys. Bargeboards with moulded lozenge decoration. E. elevation: porch has first floor 2-light casement window with mullion and high level transom. Ground floor is open-sided but with rectangular piers supporting first floor. Between piers are semi-circular arches with drop finials. Recessed doorway with C20 side lights. First floor of building otherwise has three 3-light casement windows with lattice leading. Ground floor also has 3-light casements with lattice leading and with high level transom. Lean-to verandah to right of porch on three slim columns with small drop finials along eaves.
