CONDITIONS OF SALE

2.—No person shall advance less than 1s. up to £1 and 2s. 6d. bids after that sum, or larger sums at the Auctioneer's discretion.

3.—The full purchase-money of each lot shall be paid to the Auctioneers at the fall of the hammer (if required).

4.—All lots are at the purchaser's risk on the fall of the hammer, and must be taken to with all faults and errors of description at the time of sale **and shall be paid for on the day of Sale.** No lots may be removed during the time of Sale.

5.—All lots to be cleared on day of Sale, but no lots may be removed until paid for.

6.—The Vendor reserves the right to fix a reserve price on any lot and to bid up to such price by himself or his Agent.

LASTLY.—If any person shall neglect or fail to comply with the above conditions, the Auctioneers shall be at liberty either to recover in full the amount of the lot or lots bought by such purchaser, without reference to the delivery of the same, or to re-sell such lot or lots by public or private sale, without notice to the purchaser; and the deficiency (if any) incurred by such second sale, together with all charges attending the same, shall be made good by the defaulter at this present sale, and be recoverable as and for liquidated damages.
